Sharjah has long served as the UAE's knowledge hub, a testament to the government's emphasis on the value of education. The UAE's first school and library were both founded in Sharjah, and the emirate is proud to have been the first to promote education for girls and women's rights in the 1940s.

Today, Sharjah University City encompasses the largest cluster of universities in the region. It is one of the largest college cities in the world, with 22 institutions and home to over 47,000 students from over 100 countries. More than 2,000 PhD graduates across a broad range of disciplines attend university in Sharjah.

The American University of Sharjah is the flagship institution offering programmes in architecture, engineering, business, arts and sciences. The University of Sharjah is a top-class educational facility offering a wide range of disciplines including Health Sciences, Medicine, Fine Arts and Design, Engineering and Communication. It Is Currently Home To More Than 15,000 Students.


This access to students from undergraduate to PhD level ensures a consistent flow of ideas and research, as well as a broad pool of highly-qualified graduates to recruit from.



Sharjah Research Technology & Innovation Park

The Sharjah Research, Technology, and Innovation Park (SRTI Park) is home to much of Sharjah's start-up magic: it serves as an innovation and R&D hub which leverages University City's rich pool of talent and access to key government partners to support the development, piloting, commercialisation, and adoption of R&D.

SRTI Park was launched to complement University City and has been very successful in attracting leading innovation and R&D-focused SMEs, multinationals, and startups.







The Skyway Project

SRTI Park hosts one of the largest and most developed scientific research centres of smart transport in the world. The centre focuses on modern concepts for urban transportation where technology is being developed and tested in Sharjah before it is marketed on a global scale.



The Green Homes Project

Developed as part of Merlin Digital's Sustainable Technologies Research Site, these houses are made with cutting-edge polymeric compounds and aerospace technology, offering the ability to live integrated in nature, with total comfort and high energy savings at affordable prices. Built in one day, these houses can last for a longer period of time than traditional ones.



Sharjah Open Innovation Lab (SoiLAB)

SoiLAB is an open innovation lab designed to support collaboration between Sharjah's academic institutions, start-ups and government. It combines access to labs, software, and machinery to create the optimum environment for research and innovation.

SoiLAB promotes innovative ideas that will bring technical advancement and entrepreneurship to the highest international levels in Sharjah.

The space is open to students, artists, entrepreneurs and tech enthusiasts and provides access to a diverse range of equipment from 3D printers to metal and wood working machinery and caters to individual and collaborative efforts.



Sharjah Angel Investor Network

The Sharjah Angel Investors Network (SAIN) aims to convert high-net worth individuals into angel investors who will provide capital for business start-ups. SRTI Park will provide the angel investors with a training programme to introduce the elements of angel investment and how to diversify risks, negotiate the terms of deals and deal with entrepreneurs. In the next stage, investors will learn how to pursue deals and how to support emerging companies. The angel investors will provide support to entrepreneurs in the field of emerging technology.

Sharjah Entrepreneurship Center (Sheraa)

The Sharjah Entrepreneurship Centre, also known as Sheraa is a platform where start-ups come to life. More than 110 start-ups have been born here, focused on areas from travel and tourism to sustainability to deeptech.

In just five years since it was established, these businesses have created 1300 jobs, raised \$87 million in investment, and recorded \$63 million in revenue. Sheraa has inspired a community of over 17,000 changemakers and has graduated 114 startups, 48% of whom are women.

Access Sharjah

Access Sharjah is a global platform that connects digital start-ups to relevant public and private entities in Sharjah and across the UAE. Participating entrepreneurs are given access to Sheraa's team of experts and network of global mentors, business set-up support, rent-free co-working spaces, free licensing, a pool of skilled human capital and media coverage.







Opportunities for Investors in Sharjah

Specialised Vocational Academies

Already well-known as a centre for education, Sharjah is a prime investment area for vocational training. Specialised training centres focused on sectors that are expanding across the UAE, including hospitality, transport and logistics, and additive manufacturing are likely to find a ready market.

Makerspaces, Research And Innovation Labs

Given Sharjah's commitment to innovation, there is space for further collaboration between government bodies, academia and the SME sector through hubs. Interdisciplinary spaces where accelerators and design sprints can take place are crucial to this. For spaces that can offer teams access to advanced tools and machinery in a cost-effective way, there is ample opportunity.



Early Years Learning

Sharjah aims to double its number of nurseries and encourage greater options for women in the workplace. This means there is a gap in the market for childcare centres and kindergarten offerings, a demand that is likely to increase further as Sharjah's population grows.
